Early Life

- Born on **July 12, 1997**, in Mingora, Swat Valley, Pakistan.
- Grew up in a region heavily affected by Taliban control.
- Inspired by her father, Ziauddin Yousafzai, an education advocate.
- Demonstrated a passion for learning and public speaking from a young age.

Advocacy for Education

- Began writing a blog for BBC Urdu under a pseudonym at age 11, detailing life under the Taliban.
- Spoke out publicly in 2008 against Taliban policies banning girls' education.
- Became a prominent advocate for girls' education despite threats to her life.

- Survived critical injuries and underwent treatment in Pakistan and the UK.
- The attack brought global attention to her cause and resilience.



Global Impact and Recognition

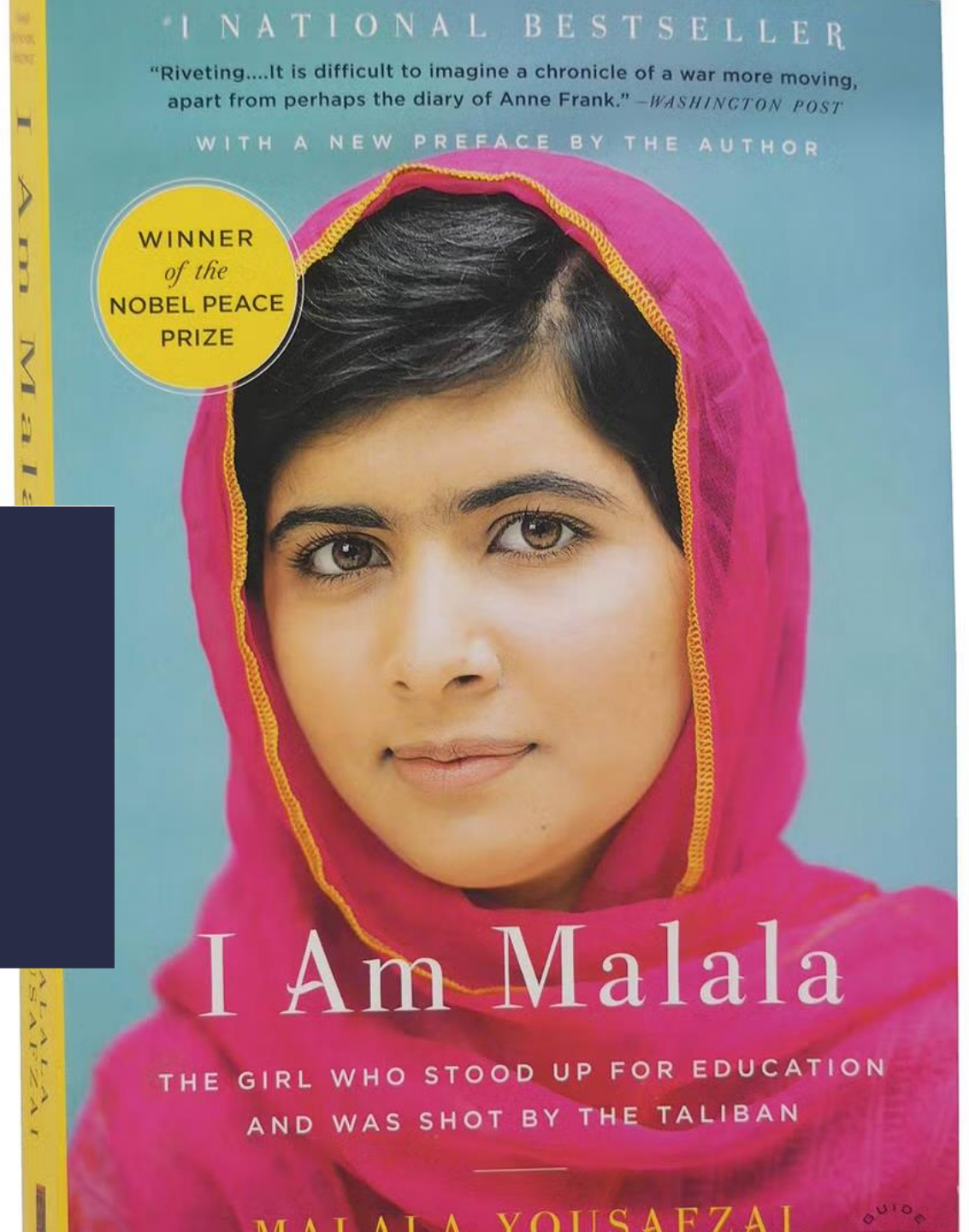
- Founded in 2013 the **Malala Fund** to support education initiatives globally.
- “I Am Malala” was published in 2013 and she has delivered speeches at major global platforms.
- Became the youngest-ever recipient of the **Nobel Peace Prize** in 2014, at age 17.



Ongoing Work and Achievements

- Graduated from **Oxford University** in 2020 with a degree in Philosophy, Politics, and Economics.
- Continues to advocate for education, particularly for girls in underserved communities.
- Recognized as one of the most influential figures in the world by Time magazine and others.
